HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to approve, under Section 71 of "The Audit Act, 1904," of the following addition to Regulation 44:—

(j.) The signature of the payee to a form of receipt endorsed on an order drawn on the Minister of a Department, or on a banker's cheque, may be accepted by public accountants as a sufficient discharge from the public creditor for the amount of such order or cheque; and if the name of the payee is signed by an agent on his behalf, together with the signature of the agent, such discharge may be accepted if certified by a bank to be a correct endorsement.
