NOTICE is hereby given that His Excellency the Governor has, this day, been pleased to issue the following Commission to the Lieutenant Governor, Sir Edward Albert Stone, appointing him Deputy with limited powers during the temporary absence of His Excellency the Governor:—

COMMISSION

By His Excellency the Right Honourable Sir William Grey Ellison-Macartney, Privy Councillor, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

To Sir Edward Albert Stone, Knight Commander of St. Michael and St. George, Lieutenant-Governor of Western Australia, Greeting:

WHEREAS by Clause 14 of the Letters Patent passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom constituting the Office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies bearing date the 29th October, 1900, it is provided that in the event of the Governor having occasion to be temporarily absent for a short period from the seat of Government or from the State, he may in every such case, by an Instrument under the Public Seal of the State, constitute and appoint the Lieutenant-Governor, or if there be no such officer then any other person, to be his Deputy during such temporary absence, and in that capacity to exercise, perform and execute, for and on behalf of the Governor, during such absence but no longer, all such powers and

authorities vested in the Governor by the said Letters Patent, as shall in and by such Instrument be specified and limited, but no others:

And whereas I, the said Governor, having occasion to be temporarily absent for a short period, not exceeding one month, from the seat of Government, and in consequence am desirous to appoint a Deputy to exercise, perform, and execute for and on my behalf the powers and authorities hereinafter specified and no others:

Now therefore I, the said Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, do by this instrument under the Public Seal of the State constitute and appoint you, the said Sir Edward Albert Stone, my Deputy during such absence to exercise, perform and execute, for and on my behalf as such Governor, all the powers and authorities hereinafter specified, viz.:—

To preside at the meetings of the Executive Council, to sign all grants, leases and documents of like nature and Treasury Warrants, and such other Documents as may be required by any Statute of this State for administrative purposes.

Given under my hand and issued under the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this twentythird day of June, 1919.
