COACHING RATES BOOK.

It is hereby notified, for general information, that the following alterations have been made to the Coaching Rates Book:—

Suburban Lines, Metropolitan, Extended, and Kalgoorlie Suburban Areas.

Ordinary return tickets will be available on day of issue only, with the exception that those issued on Saturdays will be available for return up to midnight on the following Monday.

The issue of *Excursion Tickets* is abolished.

The issue of *Workers' Daily Tickets* is abolished.

Sleeping Car Berths.—The fare for sleeping berth in first class cars is to be 12s. 6d., and in second class cars 5s.

Platform Tickets.—The charge for admission to Railway platforms is to be 3d. Periodical platform tickets will be issued as under:—

Perth and Fremantle—Six months, 15s.; twelve months, 30s.

Other stations—Six months, 7s. 6d.; twelve months, 15s.

To operate from 19th December, 1919.

Country Lines.

The passenger fares for the *single journey* are reduced ten per cent., and the issue of *Ordinary Return Tickets* is abolished.

(a.) Where it is provided in Rate Book that return tickets will be issued at single fare for the double journey or at two-thirds of return fare, single tickets at two-thirds rates will be issued for both forward and return journey.

(b.) Where it is provided that return tickets will be issued at half rates, single tickets at half rates will be issued for both outward and return journeys.

(c.) Where return tickets at half single fare are provided, single tickets at one-third rate will be issued for both journeys.

(d.) In all such cases it will be necessary to obtain certificates for both forward and return journeys and the certificate for the return journey must be presented within the time specified for the availability of return ticket.

The *Holiday Excursion Fare* is to be the single fare plus fifty per cent.

Periodical Ticket Rates.

The published rate for 3 months, 6 months, and yearly tickets are cancelled.

The fares for Quarterly periodical tickets are to be the sum of three monthly tickets less 7½ per cent.

The fares for Half-yearly tickets (Periodical) are to be the sum of two quarterly tickets less 5 per cent.

The fares for Yearly Periodical tickets are to be the sum of two half-yearly tickets less 5 per cent.

Ordinary Parcels (Prepaid) Rates.

The rates for parcels up to 56lbs. in weight are cancelled and the following substituted, viz.:—
