IT is hereby notified, for public information, that His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has approved of the following Order in Council under "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919":—

"Whereas by 'The Prices Regulation Act, 1919,' it is provided that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Commissioners, determine the maximum price which may be charged for food-stuffs in

any proclaimed area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, on the recommendation of the Commissioners appointed under the said Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby determine that the maximum retail price which may be charged for a 2lb. loaf of bread in the Metropolitan Area, as proclaimed for the purposes of the said Act, shall, as from the 19th day of January instant, be 5d. for cash or booked, including delivery."
