NOTICE is hereby given, on the recommendation of the Commissioners appointed under "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," that all persons, firms, or corporations holding stocks of Tea exceeding 500 lbs. in weight, or Coffee exceeding 200 lbs. in weight, as at noon on Saturday, the 24th January, 1920, are required to furnish to the said Commissioners returns of stocks held, or in transit, or in bond, or under the control of such persons, firms, or corporations, not later than noon on Monday, the 9th February, 1920.

Where stocks comprise bulk, packet, or tins, the respective quantities of each must be stated, and in the case of Teas, holders of stocks are required to state the quantity of bulk, unbroken packets, blended, or packed Teas respectively.
