Prices Regulation Act, 1919.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Executive Council Chamber, in Perth, this 1st day of April, 1920.

Present:

The Honourables-The Premier (Senior Member), The Minister for Mines, The Colonial Secretary.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Prices Regu-lation Act, 1919," it is enacted that the maximum prices (retail or wholesale) that may be charged in any proclaimed area for any food-stuff or necessary commodifies may on the recommendation of the Commis-sioners, be determined by Order in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby, on the recommendation of the Commissioners, determine that the maximum wholesale prices of fresh milk in the Metropolitan Area shall be as follows:-

1.

- (a) If delivered at a Depôt, one shilling and fivepence per gallon;
- (b) 1f delivered ex a Depôt, one shilling and sixthe usual terms and conditions in other respects to

apply.

And that this Order shall have effect from the first day of April, 1920.
