NOTICE is hereby given that at a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 13th day of September, 1920, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

The Prices Regulation Act, 1919.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," it is provided that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Commissioners, determine the maximum prices which may be charged for "Foodstuffs and Necessary Commodities" in any proclaimed area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, on the recommendation of the Commissioners appointed under the said Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby determine that the prices of the foodstuffs and necessary commodities mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be the maximum wholesale and retail prices that may be charged for such foodstuffs and necessary commodities within the Metropolitan Area and other proclaimed Areas.
