Page 19—Metropolitan-Suburban Fares. Delete the table shown, and insert:—

Return Tickets will be issued at double the single fares shown.

Page 20—Metropolitan-Extended Suburban Areas. Delete the fares shown. The fares to be charged on these sections will be the same as charged for the Country Lines, but Return Tickets will be issued at double the single rates.

The limits of the areas over which Return Tickets may be issued are Fremantle, Armadale *via* Jandakot, Armadale *via* Perth, Chidlow, Belmont, Karragullen, and Mundaring Weir.

Pages 28 to 44—Country Fares. Delete fares appearing on pages 28 to 44. Fares to be calculated as under—
1st Single, 2d. per mile (minimum 4d.).
2nd Single, 1½d. per mile (minimum 3d.).

Holiday Excursion Fares will be Single Fares plus two-thirds—Minima: First Class, 3s.; Second Class 2s.

Pages 45 and 46—Midland Railway Company Fares. Delete fares shown. Fares to be calculated as under:—
1st Single, 2d. per mile (minimum 4d.).
2nd Single, 1½d. per mile (minimum 3d.).

Holiday Excursion Fares will be single fare plus two-thirds. Minima First Class, 3s.; Second Class 2s.

Page 51—Race Course Fares. Add 1s. to each First Class fare shown. Add 6d. to each Second Class fare shown.

Pages 65 to 68—Periodical Tickets. Delete the fares shown under "Three months," "Six Months," and "Yearly," and insert:—

Rates for Three months will be three times the monthly rate.

Rates for Six months will be six times the Monthly rate.

Rates for Yearly will be twelve times the Monthly rate.
