### THE ABORIGINES ACT, 1905.

Amendment of Regulations.

Colonial Secretary's Office, Perth, 27th January, 1922.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to repeal existing Regulation No. 27, made under "The Aborigines Act, 1905," and to approve the following Regulation in lieu thereof:—

No permit shall be granted to an Asiatic. For the purpose of this Regulation "Asiatic" means—Any person in fact or apparently belonging to the extent of not less than the half-blood to one of the native races of Asia or of any Asiatic island or of any island of the Indian Ocean or of the Malayan Archipelago, but does not include a person of the Jewish race."
