Regulation for allowing Discount for prompt payment of Rates.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Board of any Road District is empowered to make By-laws for any of the purposes mentioned in the said Act; and whereas the Wandering Road Board doth, in exercise of the powers aforesaid, and of every power enabling it in this behalf, hereby make and publish the following By-law:—

The Board may allow to any person liable to pay any rates within thirty days after notice given him to pay the same, a discount of Five pounds per centum on the amount of the current rate.
