(1) In lots of half a ton or over shall be £10 2s. 6d. per ton of 2,000lbs.; delivery free at whole-saler's stores. Geraldton Area, £11; delivery free in Geraldton. (2s. 6d. per ton may be added to these prices when booked for more than seven days.)

(2) In lots of less than half a ton, 2s. 11/2d. per

(c) By retailers, if in lots of one bag or more:—2s. 5½d. per bushel; Geraldton, 2s. 6½d. Lesser quantities, 2s. 7½d. per bushel (delivery free at retailer's shop); Geraldton, 2s. 81/2d. per bushel (delivery free at Geraldton)

Within all proclaimed areas other than the follow-9. Within all proclaimed areas other than the following, viz., Metropolitan, Geraldton, Kellerberrin, Northam, York, Brookton, Pingelly, Narrogin, Wagin, Katanning, and Bunbury, the equivalent of any additional cost actually incurred in transportation of bran and pollard beyond the areas specified may be added to prices mentioned in paragraph 8.

10. The areas above referred to are those portions of the State comprised within the areas as declared by an Order in Council published under "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," in the Government Gazette on the 8th

day of January, 1920.
