M.W.S. 704/22. WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sew-erage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works, and Storm-water Drainage Works: And whereas it is further pro-vided that the Governor way exampt rationality more water Drainage Works: And whereas it is further pro-vided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewer-age, and Drainage of the following works under the raid Act, and does hereby count each works from the said Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act:

Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted.

Cottesloe Beach Road District.

Proposed 3-inch diameter cast-iron water main along Johnston Street, from Bay View Terrace Easterly to Johnston Parade, and along Johnston Parade from Johnston Street Southerly to Lot 32 (length about 23 chains), together with valves, hydrants, and all necessary apparatus, as shown in red on Plan M.W.S., S., & D.D. No. 4114 No. 4114.
