PROCLAMATION,

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, | By His Excellency Sir Francis AlexTO WIT. | Sander Newdegate, Knight Commander
of the Most Distinguished Order of
St. Michael and St. George, Governor
in and over the State of Western
Australia and its Dependencies in
the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is provided by the Workers Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1923, that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, do hereby, with the

advice and consent of the Executive Council, fix Monday, the second day of April, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three as the day on which the said Act shall come into operation.
