8. These regulations shall be incorporated and read as one with the Stock Diseases Regulations, 1914.

Lot 220, and along said production and Westernmost boun-dary and a South and a West boundary of said lot and the West boundary of Lots 219 and 216; thence by the Southern side of Bartram Road to the North-West corner of Lot 213 and along its West boundary and the West boundary of Lot 261, and continuing through Location 458 to intersect the Northern boundary of Lot 202.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the said intersection, and extending Westward along the South-ern side of Russell Road to intersect the shores of Jer-

voise Bay. On the Westward by the shores of Jervoise Bay and Owen Anchorage and the South side of the South Mole to the starting point.
