

8. These regulations shall be incorporated and read as one with the Stock Diseases Regulations, 1914.

The Schedule.

Bounded on the Northward by lines commencing at the Western end of the South Mole, and extending Eastward along the Northern side and to and along the Northern side of Victoria Quay and the left bank of the Swan River to Coffee Point.

On the Eastward by lines commencing at Coffee Point aforesaid, and extending Southward along the left bank of the Canning River to the production Eastward of the South side of Coomooora Road, and along said production and South side to the North-West corner of Cockburn Sound Location 28, and Southward along its West boundary and the West boundaries of Locations 338, 528, and 630; thence along the Eastern side of Dean Road and Prinsep Road to the Northern side of the Jandakot-Armadale Railway Reserve, and along said side of the Railway Reserve to the production North of the Westernmost boundary of Jandakot A.A. Lot 220, and along said production and Westernmost boundary and a South and a West boundary of said lot and the West boundary of Lots 219 and 216; thence by the Southern side of Bartram Road to the North-West corner of Lot 213 and along its West boundary and the West boundary of Lot 261, and continuing through Location 458 to intersect the Northern boundary of Lot 202.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the said intersection, and extending Westward along the Southern side of Russell Road to intersect the shores of Jervoise Bay.

On the Westward by the shores of Jervoise Bay and Owen Anchorage and the South side of the South Mole to the starting point.
