THE ABATTOIRS ACT, 1909.

HIS Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following additional Regulations under the Abattoirs Act, 1909:—

THE ABATTOIRS ACT, 1909.

Additional Regulations.

These regulations are incorporated with and shall be read as one with the Regulations published in the *Government Gazette* on the 6th day of November, 1925.

16A. No owner of stock brought to the abattoir for slaughter, and no person on behalf of such owner, shall remove or attempt to remove from the abattoir the blood or the paunch contents of any slaughtered animal.

16B. The blood and the paunch contents of all stock slaughtered in the abattoir shall become the property of the Government as part of toll for the use of the abattoir.
