PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, { By His Excellency Colonel Sir William TO WIT. } Robert Campion, Kright Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St Michael and St. George, D.S.O., Governor. Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is provided that the Governor may prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly from time to time, and dissolve the Legislative Assembly, by Proclamation or otherwise, whenever he shall think fit: And whereas the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly stand prorogued until the 31st day of January instant:

And whereas it is expedient to dissolve the Legislative Assembly: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, in exereise of the power conferred by "The Constitution Act, 1889," do hereby proclaim that the Legislative Assembly be dissolved on the 31st day of January instant.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 28th day of January, 1927.
