PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT.

J. A. NORTHMORE, Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator.

By His Excellency Sir John Alfred Northmore, K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

F. & S. 3822/21.

WHEREAS it is enacted by "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," that the expression "Public holiday" shall mean certain days therein specified, and any other day declared by Proclamation to be a public holiday for the purpose of the said Act: Now, therefore I, the said Lieut. Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby

proclaim and declare that Wednesday, the 26th day of October, 1932, shall be a public holiday in Collie for the purposes of the said Act, and shall be observed as a public holiday under every part of the said Act in which it occurs.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 25th day of October, 1932.
