HEREAS by an Instrument of Abdication dated the Tenth Day of December instantly His former Majesty King Edward the Eighth did declare his irrevocable determination to renounce the Throne for himself and his descendants, and the said Instrument of Abdication has now taken place, whereby the Imperial Crown of Great Britain, Ireland and all other His former Majesty's Dominions is now solely and rightfully come to the High and Mighty Prince Albert Frederick Arthur George, We, therefore, James Mitchell, John Alfred Northmore, John Collings Willcock, Michael Francis Troy, Selby Walter Munsie, Harold Millington, Frank Joseph Scott Wise, Albert Redvers George Hawke, William Henry Kitson, Frederick Charles Lee Smith, Edmund Harry Gray, Henry Frewen Le Fanu, Redmond Prendiville, John Waters Kirwan, Alexander Hugh Panton, Walter Hartwell James, Joseph James Poynton, Charles George Latham and Norbert Keenan, do now hereby with one voice and consent of tongue and heart publish and proclaim that the High and Mighty PRINCE ALBERT FREDERICK ARTHUR GEORGE is now become our only lawful and rightful LIEGE LORD GEORGE THE SIXTH by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India, Supreme Lord in and over the State of Western Australia: to whom we do acknowledge all faith and constant obedience, with all heart and humble affection: beseeching God, by whom Kings and Queens do reign, to bless the Royal Prince GEORGE THE SIXTH with long and happy years to reign over us.

Given under our hands and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this Twelfth day of December, in the Year of Our Lord, 1936.
