WESTERN AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, acting pursuant to section 23 of the Government Railways Act, 1904-1933, has been pleased to approve of the repeal by the Commissioner of Railways of Western Australia of By-law Number 54 and the Schedule thereto, as made under and for the purposes of the said Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 24th day of February, 1922, and amended by notice published in the *Government Gazette* from time to time thereafter as from the 1st day of March, 1940, and to substitute in lieu thereof a new by-law and Schedule thereto as follows:—

BY-LAW No. 54.

The Rules and Regulations for the guidance of all persons employed on or about the Government Railways of Western Australia shall be those set forth in the Schedule to this by-law.
