- (2) The term "vehicle" as used in paragraph (1) hereof shall include any vehicle, whatever the motive power may be, and every vehicle shall be "premises" within the meaning and for the purposes of paragraph (5) of Regulation 45 of the National Security (Supplementary Regulations plementary) Regulations.
- (3) Notwithstanding any law or contract to the contrary, a person in charge of a vehicle used as a taxicab or for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward shall not be obliged to carry in such vehicle any person who consumes intoxicating liquor therein in contravention of this Order, and shall be entitled to eject any such person from such vehicle.
- This Order shall operate and have effect as from the date of publication of the same in the Government Gazette of Western Australia.
