PURSUANT to section 2 of the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Reigning Sovereign Act, 1937, I, the said Lieutenant-Governor do hereby declare and proclaim, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, that the twelfth day of November, 1945, shall be observed as a holiday in honour of the Birthday of His Majesty King George the Sixth, in lieu of any other day which may be prescribed or appointed in that behalf under any other Act or under any industrial award or agreement.

The Health Act, 1911-1944. PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell, K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia tis Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by section 45 of the Health Act, 1911-1944, it is provided that a Local Authority, in the exercise of its powers conferred by Part 3 of the said Act may make and levy rates of different amounts in respect of portions of its district, defined for that purpose by Proclamation: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby by this Proclamation define the following portions of the Yalgoo Road Board Health District wherein rates of different amounts in respect of the said portions of such district may be levied:—(a) Central Ward (Yalgoo Area); (b) other towns, prescribed areas and
