### NURSES REGISTRATION ACT, 1921-1944.

Department of Public Health,  
Perth, 22nd November, 1946.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, acting under the provisions of the Nurses Registration Act, 1921-1944, has been pleased to repeal all the regulations heretofore made and in force under the said Act, and in lieu thereof to make new regulations as set forth in the Schedule hereunder, to come into operation and have effect as from the date of the publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*.
