AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, the 15th day of September, 1948, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1947.

Municipality of Bunbury.

Election of Mayor and Councillors.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 1349/48.

WHEREAS under section 36 C of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1947, it is provided that whilst a Commissioner is in office for any district the Governor may, whenever he thinks fit, by Order in Council, appoint

a day for holding an election of mayor and councillors for the return of the mayor and the whole number of councillors assigned to the district or the wards thereof; and whereas by Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* on the 6th day of August, 1948, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Executive Council was pleased to appoint a Commissioner for the Bunbury Municipal District until a new council is duly elected; and whereas it is desirable that an election be held for the return of a mayor and the whole number of councillors for the Bunbury Municipal District: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act and all powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby appoint the 30th day of October, 1948, for holding an election for the return of a mayor and nine councillors, of whom there shall be three councillors each from North Ward, South Ward and Central Ward of the Bunbury Municipal District.
