WHEREAS by the Constitution Act, 1889-1950, it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legis-lative Assembly from time to time, by Proclama-tion or otherwise, whenever he shall think fit: Now, therefore I, the said Administrator, the officer for the time being administering the Government of the State in everyise of the power conferred by the State, in exercise of the power conferred by

the said Act, do hereby prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly until Tuesday, the 16th day of October, 1951.
