 TRAFFIC ACT, 1919-1951.

 Department of Local Government,
 Perth, 28th December, 1951.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by the Traffic Act, 1919-1951, has been pleased to amend, in the manner set out in the Schedule hereunder, the Traffic Regulations, 1936, made under and for the purposes of the said Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 26th day of August, 1936, and amended by notices published in the *Government Gazette* from time to time thereafter.

 Schedule.

The abovementioned regulations are amended as follows:—

(i) By deleting the interpretation of "The City Block, Perth" contained in regulation 4 and substituting in lieu thereof the following interpretation:—

"The City Block, Perth" means all that portion of the municipal district of the City of Perth shown depicted in diagram marked "A" hereunder and contained within and bounded by the furthermost building lines of—

Wellington Street—between George Street and Lord Street;
 Lord Street—between Wellington Street and Victoria Square;
 That portion of Victoria Square West of the Eastern building lines of Lord Street and Victoria Avenue;

Victoria Avenue—between Victoria Square and St. George's Terrace;

St. George's Terrace—between Victoria Avenue and St. George's Place;

St. George's Place and George Street—between St. George's Terrace and Wellington Street.
