PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 729.

Kitchenware.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 729.

2. Prices Control Order No. 527 is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph 3 thereof the following words—

“kitchenware” means any cooking or kitchen utensil which is or may be used in the kitchen, including the utensils specified hereunder, but not including utensils of china, glass or earthenware;

and inserting in their stead the following words—

“kitchenware” means any cooking or kitchen utensil which is or may be used in the kitchen, including the utensils specified hereunder, but not including those electrically operated, or utensils of china, glass or earthenware.
