Prices Control Order No. 745.

Cartage of Bricks and Tiles.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1948, I, George Robert Marshall Garratt, Delegate of the Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control No. 745.

2. Prices Control Order No. 685 is hereby amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph 3 thereof the figures “£1 17s. 6d.” wherever appearing and inserting in their stead the figures “£2 2s. 6d.”

(b) by omitting the Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the Schedule to this Order—
