PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Notice—Declaration No. 76.

I, ARTHUR VALENTINE RUTHERFORD ABBOTT, Attorney General and Minister of the Crown for the time being charged with the administration of the Prices Control Act, 1948-1951, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 14 of the said Act and the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, do hereby revoke Declarations Nos. 72 and 73, dated the 17th day of October, 1952, made under the said Act, and published in the *Government Gazette* on that date, in so far as they respectively refer to the goods and services sold or supplied by Commonwealth Hostels Limited (Incorporated in Victoria) specified in the Schedule to this Declaration No. 76.

PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 774.

Cartage Rates—Wheat, Oats, Other Grains or Cereals, Chaff, Potatoes and Superphosphate.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 774.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 603 is hereby revoked.

Maximum Rates.

3. I fix and declare the maximum rate at which the service of transporting by road, including loading and unloading, any of the following goods, that is, wheat, oats, or other grain or cereals, or potatoes, chaff, superphosphate or other inorganic fertiliser, for any of the distances specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order may be supplied by any person, to be the rate set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite each such distance. Provided that if the person to whom such service is supplied, assists or supplies, assistance in the loading of those goods, the maximum rate fixed by the provisions of this paragraph shall be reduced by an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. per ton.
