FREMANTLE HARBOUR TRUST ACT, 1902-1951.

Amendment of Regulations.

THE Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners, acting pursuant to section 65 of the Fremantle Harbour Trust Act, 1902-1951, hereby amend the regulations made by them and in force under the said Act published in the *Government Gazette* of the 5th day of September, 1934, and amended from time to time thereafter (reprinted by the Government Printer with all amendments to the 3rd day of October, 1952) in the manner mentioned in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

Regulation No. 249 of the abovementioned regulations is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

- (4) This regulation shall not apply to any package handled into or out of vehicles where the weight of the package is 5 tons or less, and where the package is subject to the payment of handling charges as prescribed in Regulations Nos. 143, or 144 or 145.

Passed by a resolution of the Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners at a meeting of the said Commissioners held on the fourteenth day of November, 1952.
