PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1952.

Prices Control Order No. 794.

Ales, Lagers and Stouts—Perth Metropolitan Area.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

## Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 794.
2. Prices Control Order No. 688 is hereby amended—
  - (a) by inserting immediately after paragraph 4 thereof, the following paragraph:—
    4. (a) Any price fixed by paragraph 4 of this Order for the sale of bottled ale, lager and stout for consumption other than on the seller's premises shall include any charge made for or in respect of any container or wrapping in which or with which the goods are sold.
  - (b) by inserting immediately after paragraph 7 thereof, the following paragraph:—
    8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order where any notice in writing fixing the maximum price of any ale, lager or stout was given in pursuance of any Order, which was by virtue of the Prices Control Act, 1948-1952, in force immediately prior to the commencement of this Order, that notice in writing shall be deemed to have been given under this Order and shall continue in full force and effect.
  - (c) by omitting the Schedule to the Order, and inserting in its stead the Schedule to this Order.
