LAND ACQUISITION.

Kununoppin-Trayning Road Board—Drainage.

NOTICE is hereby given, and it is hereby declared, that the several pieces or parcels of land described in the Schedule hereto—being all in the Avon District—have, in pursuance of the written approval under the Roads District Act, 1919-1948 and the Public Works Act, 1902-1950 of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, dated the 11th day of February, 1953, been compulsorily taken and set apart for the purposes of the following public work, namely :—Drainage.

And further notice is hereby given that the said pieces or parcels of land so taken and set apart are shown marked off on Plan, P.W.D., W.A., 33569 (L.T.O. Diagram 17528), which may be inspected at the Office of the Minister for Works, Perth.

And it is hereby directed that the said lands shall vest in Kununoppin-Trayning Road Board for an estate in fee simple in possession for the public work herein expressed, freed and discharged from all trusts, mortgages, charges, obligations, estates, interests, rights-of-way, or other easements whatsoever.
