### PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1952.

Prices Control Order No. 842.

Portland Cement (Grey).

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantine Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

#### Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 842.
2. Prices Control Order No. 776 as amended by Prices Control Order No. 839, is hereby further amended by omitting the First Schedule thereto as amended and inserting in its stead the Schedule to this Order.
