PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1952.

Prices Control Order No. 907.

Onions—Sales by Growers and Wholesalers.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantine Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 907.

2. Prices Control Order No. 785 is hereby amended—

A. by omitting subparagraph (a) (ii) of paragraph 5 thereof and inserting in its stead the following:—

(ii) a margin at the rate of 2s. 9d. per cwt. if sold ex wholesale store, or at the rate of 3s. 3d. per cwt. if delivered free on rail; or at the rate of 3s. 6d. per cwt. if delivered to the purchaser's premises or free on wharf; or at the rate of 3s. 6d. per cwt., plus cost of transport from wharf to vessel if sold free on board;

B. by omitting the Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the Schedule to this Order.
