WHEREAS under section 12 (1) of the Electoral Districts Act, 1947, it is provided that the State may from time to time be wholly or partially redivided into Electoral Districts and Electoral Provinces by Commissioners appointed under section 12 of that Act in manner provided by that Act whenever directed by the Governor by proclamation; and whereas it is desired that the State shall be wholly so redivided and that a date should be proclaimed for the purposes of sections 3 and 10 of the said Act: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Coun-cil, do hereby direct and proclaim that the State shall be wholly redivided into Electoral Districts and Electoral Provinces by Commissioners appointed under section 12 of the said Act in manuer prounder section 12 of the said Act in manner pro-vided by the said Act, and I declare and proclaim the date of the publication and issue of this pro-clamation to be the date as from which the Com-missioners appointed under the said Act shall per-form and observe the several duties imposed upon them by section 3 of the Act.
