TRAFFIC ACT, 1919-1956.

Department of Local Government, Perth, 5th April, 1957.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by the Traffic Act, 1919-1957, has been pleased to make the regulations set out in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

Regulations.

1. In these regulations the Traffic Regulations, 1954, published Principal in the Government Gazette on the 15th December, 1954, as amended in the Government Gazette on the 15th December, 1954, as amended by the regulations amending the same published in the Gazette on the 9th February, 1955; the 1st April, 1955; the 11th May, 1955; the 17th June, 1955; the 9th August, 1955; the 30th September, 1955; the 30th December, 1955; the 24th April, 1956; the 23rd October, 1956; the 16th November, 1956; the 23rd November, 1956; the 21st December, 1956; the 22nd February, 1957; and the 8th March, 1957, are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended by $_{\rm Reg.4}$ adding before the interpretation "parking stall" interpretations as amended. follows-

> "official traffic sign" means a traffic sign or direction authorised or required under this Act to be displayed, marked, placed, or erected, and includes a parking sign:

> "parking sign" means a traffic sign described in the Sixth Schedule to these regulations under Figure 2A, 2B, 3, 3A, 3B, 3C, 3E, or 3F or a commercial stand sign and includes any other sign erected on the side or kerb of a road for the purpose of giving public notice of a regulation made under the Act prohibiting or restrict-ing the parking or standing of vehicles on that road.
