### CONSTITUTION ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1899-1958.

1. The regulations made pursuant to section 41A of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899 (as amended), published in the *Government Gazette* on the 3rd day of January, 1947, and amended by notices published in the *Government Gazette* on the 25th November, 1949, the 10th April, 1952, the 19th July, 1956, the 1st May, 1957 and the 26th February, 1959, are referred to as the principal regulations.

Regulation 2  
amended.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding to paragraph B the following proviso:—

Provided that when travelling to the Eastern States of Australia on board a ship or on a train, reimbursement of expenses shall be at a rate equal to thirty per centum of the amount of the first class single boat fare, or as the case may be, the first class single rail fare.
