Don : NOW, THEREFORE I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council do hereby declare that the flower of the plant known as the Kangaroo Paw and more fully described as *Anigosanthos Manglesii* D. Don be adopted and recognised as the floral emblem of the State of Western Australia.
