#### LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1960-1961.

The Municipality of the Shire of Perth.

By-laws Relating to Local Government Act—Regulations.

L.G. 384/61.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and of all other powers enabling it, the Council of the abovementioned Municipality hereby records having resolved on the 7th day of August, 1962, to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor the following By-laws:—

The By-laws of the Shire of Perth published in the Government Gazette of the 29th June, 1960, are hereby amended in the following manner:—

1. By-laws 126, 127 and 128 are repealed and the following new By-laws inserted in their place:—  $\,$ 

Annual Statements, Accounting, Books of Account and Finance and Forms.

127. The Local Government Accounting Directions, 1961, were published in the *Government Gazette* of 28th April, 1961.

2. By-laws 133 to 150 are repealed and the following new By-laws are inserted in their place:—  $\,$ 

#### Limitation of Terms of Loans.

133. By Order in Council made pursuant to section 608 of the Act and published in the *Government Gazette* of 5th May, 1961, the maximum terms of loans were limited as follows:—

- (1) Loans for Motor Vehicles—5 years.
- (2) Loans for Road-making Machinery—7 years.
- (3) Loans for road construction and reconstruction—15 years.

### Polls Regulations.

134. The Local Government Polls Regulations, 1961, were published in the Government Gazette of 22nd June, 1961.

#### Re-vesting of Land in Crown.

135. The Local Government (Revesting of Land) Regulations, 1961, were published in the Government Gazette of 22nd June, 1961.
