PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Major-General Sir Douglas

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section five of the Stock Diseases Act, 1895-1960, that, in any case where he deems it necessary for the purpose of preventing the introduction or dissemination of disease into or in the State, the Governor may, from time to time by Proclamation, prohibit the introduction into the State from any other State of the Commonwealth specified in the Proclamation of any infected stock or stock suspected to be infected for such specified period as may appear to him necessary or expedient for the purpose; and whereas a disease known as "Swine Fever" being a disease to which swine are subject has been found in swine in the State of New South Wales and the Governor deems it necessary, for the purposes of preventing the introduction or dissemination of that disease into or in the State, to prohibit the introduction into this State of all swine and all carcasses of any swine, other than pig meats that are in sealed containers not exceeding 2 lb. gross weight, from the State of New South Wales: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby prohibit for a period of six months from and including the 1st day of December, 1963, the introduction into this State of all swine and all carcasses of any swine, other than pig meats that are in sealed containers not exceeding 2 lb. gross weight, from the State of New South Wales.
