CONVICTED INEBRIATES REHABILITATION ACT, 1963.

Chief Secretary's Department, Perth, 14th October, 1964.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by the Interpretation Act, 1918-1962, and the Convicted Inebriates Rehabilitation Act, 1963, has been pleased to make the regulations set out in the schedule hereto, to take effect on the date on which the Act last abovementioned comes into operation.

Regulations.

Citation. 1. These regulations may be cited as the Convicted Inebriates Regulations, 1964.

Interpretation. In these regulations—
"Act" means the Convicted Inebriates Rehabilitation Act, 1963;

"inmate" means a person placed in an institution, under the provisions of the Act;

"Superintendent" means the person, for the time being, in charge of an institution.
