Unless specially or generally exempted by the Com-missioner, every motor car, motor wagon and articulated vehicle provided by a driving instructor, for the purposes of instruction, shall be fitted with such duplicate pedals, directly in front of the seat beside the driver, as will en-able the instructor readily and effectually to operate the footbrake, and disengage the transmission of the vehicle.
