SUPREME COURT ACT, 1935-1964, and GUARDIANSHIP OF INFANTS ACT, 1926-1965.

WE, the Honourable Sir Albert Asher Wolff, K.C.M.G., Chief Justice of Western Australia, The Honourable Sir Lawrence Walter Jackson, Kt., Senior Puisne Judge, and the Honourable John Evenden Virtue, the Honourable Roy Vivian Nevile, the Honourable Gordon Bede D'Arcy, the Honourable John Hale and the Honourable Oscar Joseph Negus, Puisne Judges of the Supreme Court of Western Australia, acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Supreme Court Act, 1935, and the

Guardianship of Infants Act, 1926-1965, and of every other power enabling us in that behalf, make the following rules.

RULES.

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Supreme Court (Guardianship of Infants) Rules, 1966.
 - 2. In these rules-
 - "Act" means the Guardianship of Infants Act, 1926-1965:
 - "clerk" means a clerk of the Summary Relief Court;
 - "Registrar" has the same meaning as the expression has in, and for the purposes of, the Supreme Court Act, 1935;
 - "Summary Relief Court" means the court established under that name by the Married Persons and Children (Summary Relief) Act, 1965.
