AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber at Perth this 13th day of July, 1966, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Electoral Districts Act, 1947-1965.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the Electoral Commissioners appointed under subsection (1) of section two of the Electoral Districts Act, 1947-1965, have duly performed the duties imposed upon them by that Act, and have forwarded to the Minister to whom the administration of the Electoral Act, 1907-1964, is for the time being committed, their final report upon and final recommendations for the division of the State into Electoral Districts and Electoral Provinces, with the name and boundaries of each proposed District and Province, and the number of electors in each, respectively, as nearly as can be ascertained, together with a map signed by the Commissioners showing the boundaries aforesaid; and whereas in accordance with section eleven of that Act, the Minister has presented the final report and final recommendations of the Commissioners to the Governor; and whereas it is enacted (inter alia) by subsection (2) of section eleven of the Electoral Districts Act, 1947-1965, that as soon as practicable after the Governor receives the report and final recommendations of the Commissioners pursuant to that section, the Governor shall by Order in Council promulgate those final recommendations: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth by this Order in Council promulgate those final recommendations as shown in the schedule hereto.
