In these regulations the Fire Brigades Act Regulations as regulations. reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, and and published in the Government Gazette on the 28th April, 1965, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices published in the Government Gazette, are referred to as the principal regulations.

- 2. Regulation 158 of the principal regulations is amended by adding after subregulation (2) the following subregulations:— $\,$
 - (3) Where an active registered member is absent from duty with a brigade, by reason of the operation of the National Service Act, 1951 (as amended) of the Commonwealth, he continues as an active registered member of the brigade, but, notwithstanding that continued membership and any provision of this regulation to the contrary, his place may be filled, during his absence, as provided by regulation 167 of these regulations.
 - (4) Where the Board has filled the place of an active registered member of a brigade pursuant to subregulation (3) of this regulation, and that member returns to active duty with the brigade, the Board shall not fill the vacancy occurring first after his return to active duty, with the intent that the complement of the brigade shall be restored to, and be maintained at, the level of twenty-five active registered members, as soon as practicable.
