PUBLIC SERVICE ACT, 1904-1963.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council acting under the provisions of the Public Service Act, 1904-1963, has been pleased on the recommendation of the Public Service Commissioner to make the regulations set out in the schedule hereunder.

Schedule. Regulations.

1. In these regulations the Public Service (Cadetship) Regula- Principal tions made under the Public Service Act, 1904-1963, and published regulations. in the Government Gazette on 14th October, 1964, as amended by a notice published in the Government Gazette on 26th August, 1966, are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. The principal regulations are amended by substituting for General every reference therein, other than in clause 4 of Appendix No. 1 Amendm and clause 4 of Appendix No. 2, to an amount of money, whether expressed in words or figures, a reference to the amount of money expressed in terms of decimal currency that corresponds to the firstmentioned amount calculated on the basis of the equivalents set out in Part A of the Second Schedule to the Decimal Currency Act, 1965.

3. Clause 4 of Appendix No. 1 of the principal regulations is amended-

- (a) by adding after the clause number "4" the subclause designation "(1)";
- (b) by substituting for the passage, "two hundred and fifty pounds (250)" in the last two lines of the clause, the passage, "five hundred dollars (\$500) less the deductible amount, if any, ascertained in accordance with subclause (2) of this clause"; and
