Regulations.

1. In these regulations the Factories and Shops (Rostered Principal Extraordinary Trading Hours) the Factories and Ships (Rostered Frindpal Extraordinary Trading Hours) Regulations, 1964, published in the regulations. Esso Servicentre, Corner Milligan and Wellington Streets, Perth—13th March, 1967, to 17th March, 1967.
