LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1925-1954.

Note.

1. Section 60—among other things, provides as follows:—

- (a) Plans of proposed works to be prepared, and a description thereof published in the *Government Gazette* and a local newspaper.
- (b) Such plans and description to be open to inspection by any person interested, who may make copies and extracts therefrom.
- (c) If within a period of one month after such publication, a petition against the proposed works is presented to the Minister, signed by persons who constitute a majority of the owners of rateable land within the district, the Board shall not carry out the proposed works.
- (d) If no such petition is presented legal formalities may be concluded, and the Board empowered to undertake the construction of the works.

2. Section 88—authorises the Board to impose rates to be called "drainage rates" in respect of all rateable land within the district.
