- Section 60—among other things, provides as follows:-
 - (a) Plans of proposed works to be prepared, and a description thereof published in the Government Gazette and a local newspaper.
 - (b) Such plans and description to be open to
 - (b) Such plans and description to be open to inspection by any person interested, who may make copies and extracts therefrom.
 (c) If within a period of one month after such publication, a petition against the proposed works is presented to the Minister, signed by persons who constitute a majority of the owners of rateable land within the district, the Board shall not carry out the proposed works.
 (d) If no such patition is presented legal for
 - (d) If no such petition is presented legal formalities may be concluded, and the Board empowered to undertake the construction of the works.
- 2. Section 88—authorises the Board to impose rates to be called "drainage rates" in respect of all rateable land within the district.
