NURSES REGISTRATION ACT, 1921-1959.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the provisions of the Nurses Registration Act, 1921-1959, has been pleased to make the regulations set forth in the schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

Regulations.

1. In these regulations the Nursing Aides Regulations, 1959, Principal published in the Government Gazette on the 6th October, 1959, and reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, in the Government Gazette on the 30th June, 1966, incorporating all amendments up to and including the 14th February, 1966 and subsequently amended by a notice so published on the 15th December, 1966, are referred to as the principal regulations. 1966, are referred to as the principal regulations.

- 2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding Reg. 2 after the word, "instruction" in line one of the interpretation, amended. "training" the words, "and clinical practice."

 - 3. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended—
- Reg. 5 amended.
- (a) by adding after the regulation designation "5." the sub-regulation designation "(1)";
- (b) by substituting for the words, "the curriculum" in lines four and five of paragraph (f), the passage, "either Curriculum "A" or Curriculum "B""; and
- (c) by adding a subregulation as follows:-
 - (2) An institution shall provide supervised practice for students or otherwise arrange for such practice to be taken at another approved hospital. .
